- across research outputs
- at a European, national, and institutional level



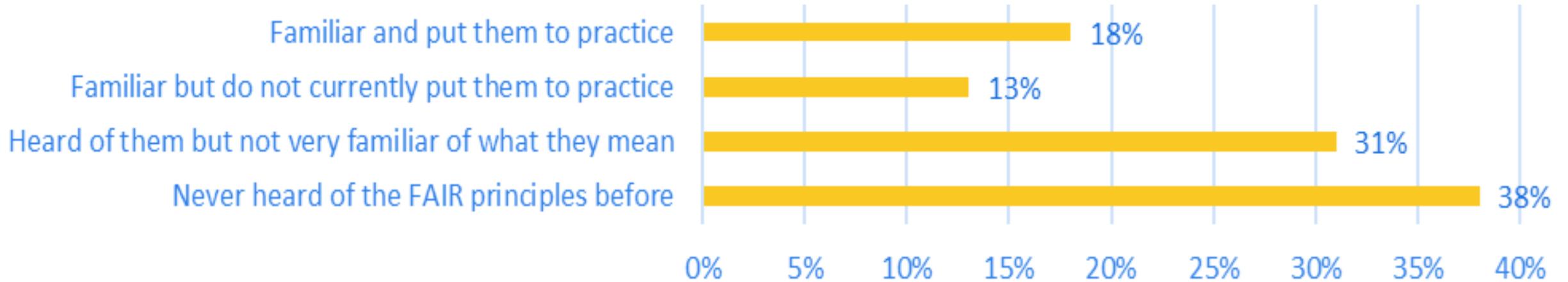

FAIR-IMPACT overall objective: how

- Engage with a wide range of stakeholders, using multiple coordination and support mechanisms to optimize alignment
- Identify together with domain specific partners current and emerging FAIR-enabling components (these can be anything like practices, policies, tools, technical specs)
- Translate these to be adoptable in other domains or for other types of outputs and support the application in these other fields.
- Define the support, governance and coordination mechanisms that are needed to make sure that all of these what we call FAIR-enabling practices will also continue to function in the EOSC in the future.

FAIR awareness

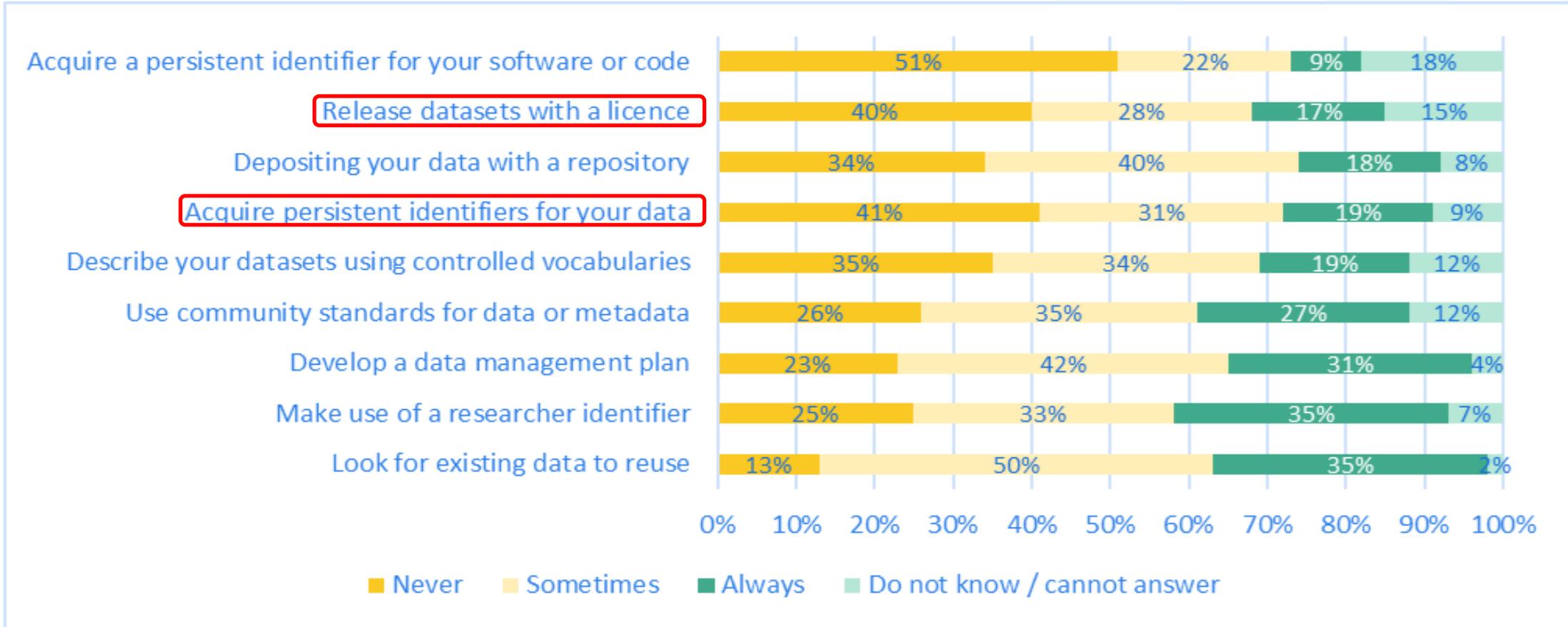


- About two thirds have some level of familiarity with the FAIR principles
- More than a third have never heard of them
- Less than 1 out of 5 puts them into practice

FAIR-IMPACT project design

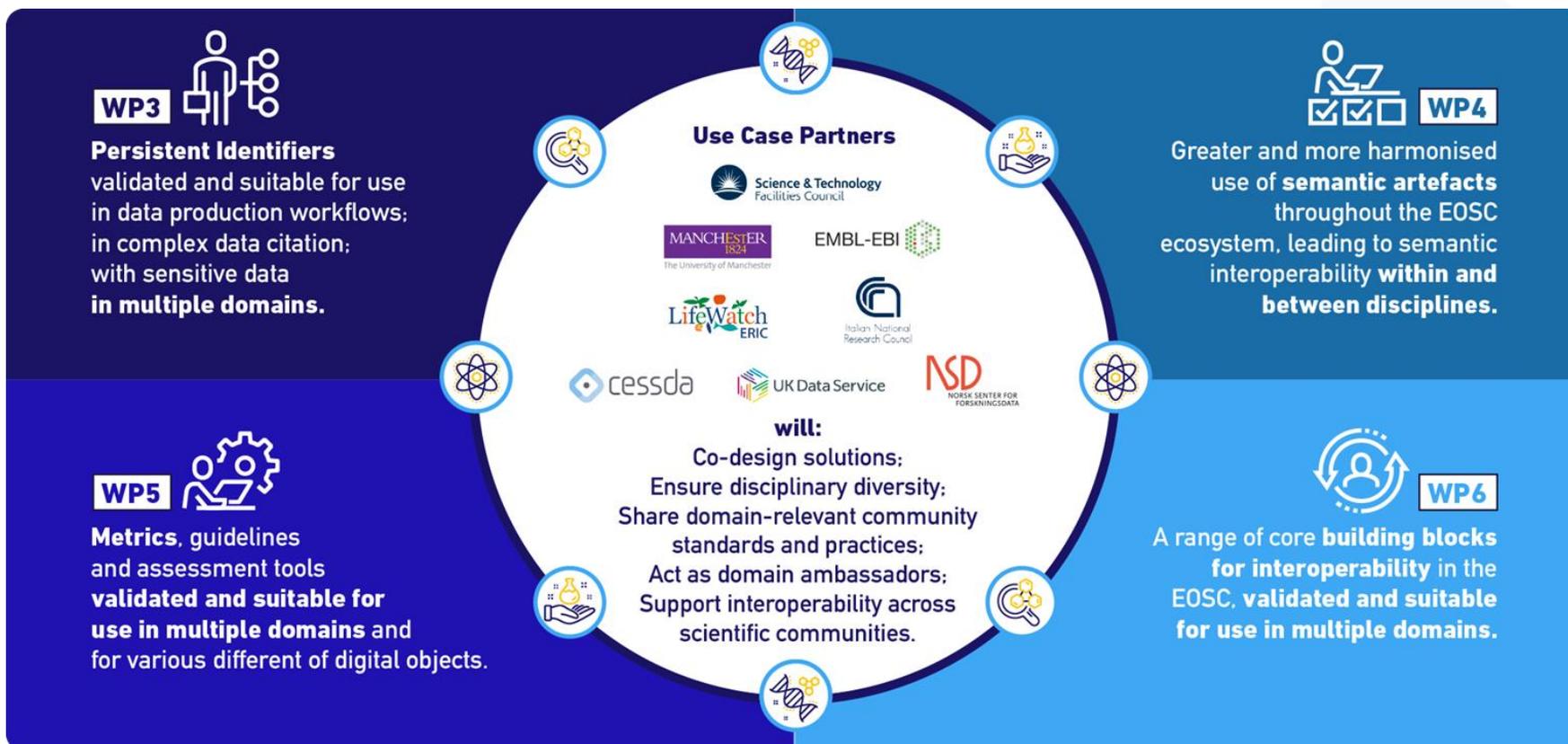
FAIR-IMPACT PROJECT DESIGN - WORK PACKAGES



A range of governance, coordination and collaboration mechanisms necessary for a functioning FAIR research ecosystem:

- Adoption of FAIR-enabling components and mechanisms at multiple levels among a diverse group of stakeholders using a wide range of tools and Support Tiers;
- A persistent identifier support programme and guidance for the provision of PID services in EOSC, incl. mechanisms for adoption and implementation;
- A semantic framework for the governance, creation, mapping, sharing, reuse, FAIRness assessment and interoperability of semantic artefacts for EOSC;
- Guidelines and prototypes to support both enabling FAIR and assessing the FAIRness and trustworthiness of different types of digital objects in multiple domains;
- Components for increased legal, organisation, semantic and technical interoperability within and across disciplines.

Practical implementation of the FAIR principles starting with integrated use cases on four scientific domains



Social Sciences and Humanities

The F-UJI tool will be adapted to fit SSH relevant community standards for FAIR

Photon & Neutron science

A range of components for cross-domain research data description will be tested

Life science

Data provenance will be better documented by extending RO-Crate to practices on PID usage

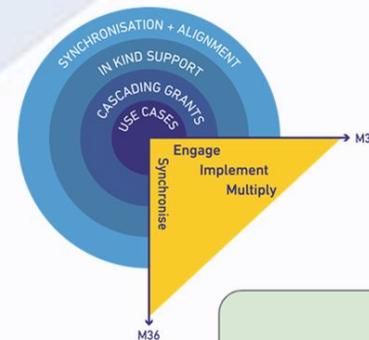
Agri-food

Metadata providers will implement a common API for federating access to semantic artefacts

- 3 support routes
 - In-kind: dedicated guidance and 1:1 support
 - Cascading grants: support to test and implement specific tools, approaches and solutions
 - Series of public FAIR Implementation workshops

- two of five open calls for support have been launched so far

- future calls:
 - January 2024
 - April 2024
 - September 2024



Tier 4: Supporting EOSC-readiness through harmonisation and dissemination activities (*Synchronisation Force + activity with the EU Data Spaces [SUPPORT ONLY]*)

Tier 3: Onboarding via in-kind support programs (*via provision of toolkits, frameworks & examples [SUPPORT ONLY]*)

Tier 2: Targeted adoption & implementation funding (*via Cascading Grants [EUR]*)

Tier 1:
 Integrated use cases covering the ESFRI Cluster domains (*Consortium Partners [EUR]*)
 Integrated use cases coming from Consortium Partners (*where considered part of their task contribution*)
