- 1st Managing rights, access and licences is clear, coherent and simple
- 2nd Organisational and legal interoperability are catered for
- 3rd Services are interoperable in terms of rights and access management
- 4th Interoperable metadata is generated, captured and shared
- 5th Data management planning data is shared with as many services as possible

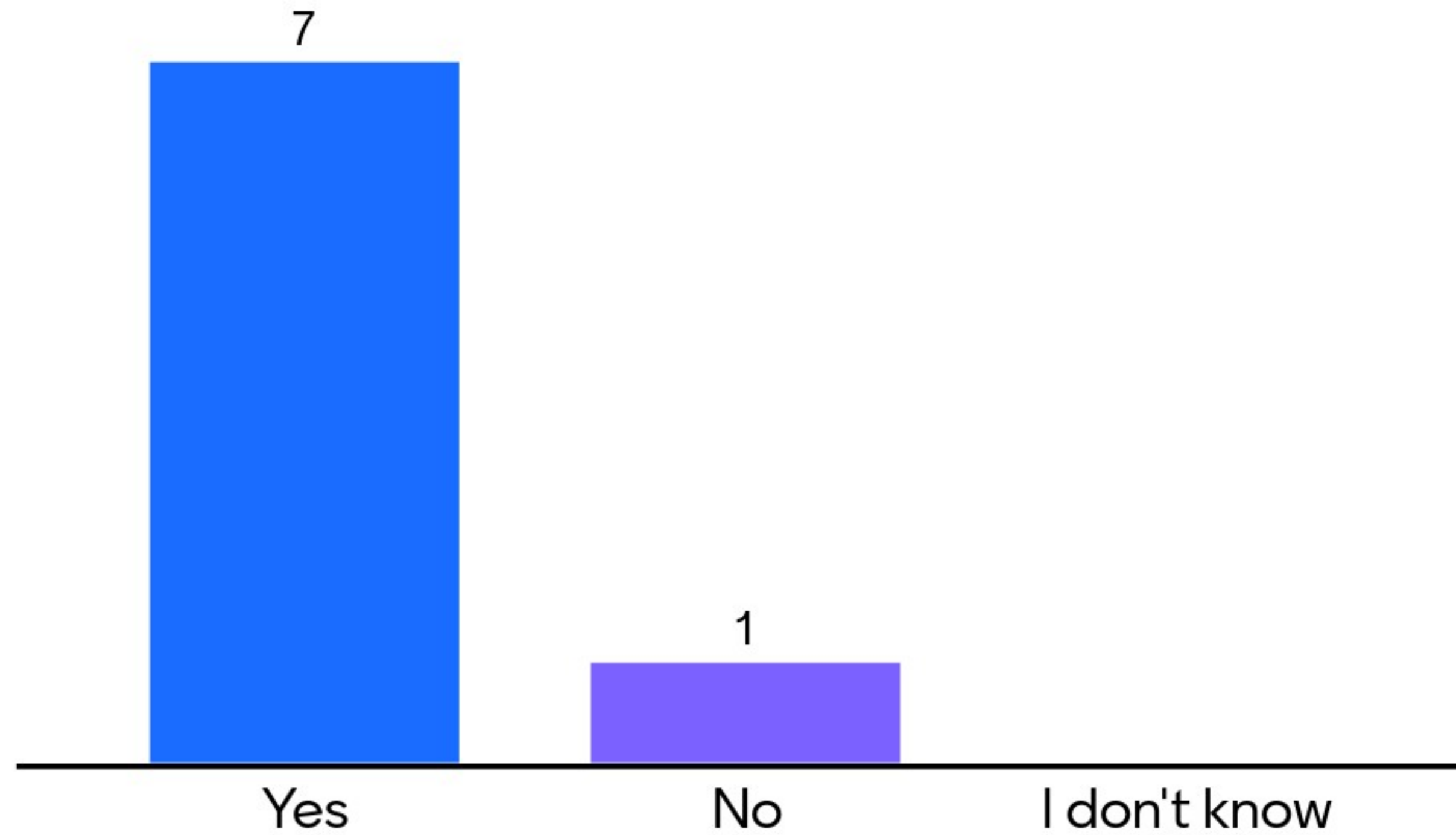
